Education Requirement for Membership

Membership Qualifications:

To qualify for active membership in a local squadron of USPS/America's Boating Club:

- You must be able and willing to contribute time, energy, and skills to the objective of USPS/America's Boating Club.
- You must have paid all applicable entrance fees, dues, and assessments.
- Your membership application must be accepted by your local squadron's executive committee or the Membership Chair.

Don't have a local squadron? National "cyber" memberships are also available.
